

#### **MATERIALS**



# Mark and prepare the bin

 Trace a circle approximately six inches in diameter with marker on either side of plastic storage bin.




## the interior

 Line bottom of bin with a thin layer of straw, then line inside walls with sheets of reflective insulation sheets.

Insulate and line

• Add holes to insulation sheets that line up with holes in storage bins.



### 2 - Cut the entry/exit holes

- Use hair dryer to warm area for 1-2 minutes.
- Once plastic is warm and pliable, use jig saw or box cutter to cut holes where marked.
- Line edges with strips of duct tape to anchor the insulation and make the edges safe.



### 4 – Position the shelter

 Place lidded bins in a safe, sheltered space with both exits clear. Community cats thank you for their new home!
