

How do I know if a kitten is in distress?

So you've found a kitten—or maybe a whole litter. PAUSE and assess the situation!

- Are the kittens in immediate danger (like in a road or near heavy equipment)? If so, carefully move them to a nearby safe spot.
- Are the kittens in distress, dirty, visibly injured, or sick? If so, immediately call 828-250-6430 during hours. If the kittens seem healthy and happy, leave them alone! Kittens are happiest and safest with their mom in an environment that is comfortable for her. Contact the Buncombe County Animal Shelter to file a found report and for supplies, support, and other resources.
- Is mom in the area? If so, she's taking care of her babies—and that's the best-case scenario!
 You can still help by offering food, water, and shelter nearby, and contact us to file a found report and for supplies, support, and other resources. If mom is not in the area, please refer to step #4.
- Mother cats will leave for 2-3 hours to hunt. If mom is not in the area or has not returned after 3 hours, call us at 828-250-6430 for assistance with caring for abandoned kittens or visit our website for advice!
